Maple Class have had a busy few weeks of learning.

In English the children have been learning all about instructional texts, exploring all of the key features that they include. They then created their own instructional text about how to build their own toy using the skills they learnt in their Design and Technology lessons.

In maths they have been learning all about fractions. The children have been exploring unit and non-unit fractions as well as comparing and ordering fractions. They also improper and mixed fractions.

In Computing the children have started to create their own branching databases using a variety of online systems. They have been exploring how to identify appropriate questions to identify different criteria.

In their Design and Technology lessons the children have been exploring 'mechanisms'. They learnt all about forces, linkages and levers before designing and creating their own catapults and 'linkage toy'. Well done Maple Class.
