This week we have been learning:

- We read the story 'Can't you sleep little bear' as a class and discussed why the dark is good.
- Reception children have been learning to blend using 'Special friends, fred talk, read the word'. They have also been learning sounds like th, nk and ch.
- The year 1 children have been focusing on writing sentences independently that include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
